The goal is to get as many gymnasts/supporters participating in the Scotia Bank Run in order to raise as much money for our gym clubs in Ontario as possible. Last year, Gymnastics Canada raised as much as \$17,000! Most fundraising takes place throughout September and the first ten days of October.

The Scotia Bank Run will take place on **Sunday, September 26th, 2010** at the Toronto Waterfront.

Entry fees range from approximately \$48 to \$113. The last day to enter a participant in the marathon is Monday, September 20, 2010.
